- Raised \$10,000 to provide housing and education to street children in Dhaka, and for the construction of a children's village in Haluaghat in northern Bangladesh: Wrote a concept note for the children's village; organized a charity concert in Germany; acted as an intermediary between my local partner organization and corporate donors, including McKinsey & Company; wrote proposals for different parts of the construction project; planned and executed outreach campaigns and fundraising drives on social media and offline; created and maintained budgets; drafted contracts and prepared progress reports, financial updates, and presentations; tracked deadlines and deliverables
- Matched children orphaned by the 2013 Rana Plaza collapse with private donors in Germany to cover their schooling and health care expenses, raising a total of \$20,000: Provided donors with profiles of and updates about their sponsored children; met with the children to evaluate their needs; fostered relationships between the donors and the children through the exchange of letters and gifts
- Coordinated the emergency medical evacuation of a 6-year-old girl in a rural community in western Bangladesh who had suffered severe burn injuries to a specialized clinic in Dhaka and raised funds for her treatment and recovery; identified and solved logistical and other problems during her stay in Dhaka; successfully set up a scholarship fund for her school education once she had recovered; the total amount raised was about \$2,500

Project and Event Management and Leadership

- Conceptualized and co-organized an international student conference on social and political activism and strategies to achieve local and global change with participants from 14 countries, mostly in the Global South: Wrote the call for abstract; coordinated the selection of abstracts; handled logistics, such as registration; disbursed honoraria; chaired the selection committee for the Best Paper Award
- Coordinated the Master of Arts program in Ethics of Governance and Public Service at the University of Dar es Salaam in Tanzania and led efforts to build capacity and increase retention
- Led a student organization that organized more than 22 public events with speakers from 6 countries at the University of Heidelberg in Germany: Successfully raised \$7,000 in grants; made travel and accommodation arrangements; chaired planning meetings; created promotional material and co-authored an organizational handbook; developed and maintained a website for the organization

Communication, Public Engagement, and Outreach

- Wrote an informational brochure about LGBTIQ+ rights with partners at the Bandhu Social Welfare Society and Boys of Bangladesh, arranged for it to be translated into Bengali, and raised the funds necessary to get it printed and distributed in both English and Bengali
- Planned and executed a campaign in Kiswahili against anti-LGBTIQ+ discrimination in East Africa
- Advised an animal welfare organization in Tanzania on effective fundraising and made their website
- Created and have been running for 12 years a Facebook page dedicated to the promotion of LGBTIQ+ rights in Bangladesh (monthly reach: 10,000); a book in which LGBTIQ+ followers of this page share their experiences with violence, discrimination, and prejudice is in the works
- Facilitated the translation of 2 animal ethics books into Bengali and 1 into Kiswahili; raised funds for the translations and to subsidize printing costs; coordinated the printing process and the distribution of books to local animal welfare organizations in Bangladesh and Tanzania
- Delivered more than 40 public lectures to diverse audiences in 15 countries; spoke at schools, colleges, universities, a law school, the UN Economic Commission for Africa, Bangladesh's Ministry of Planning, and a number of nonprofits; talked on TV and radio
- Spoke at rallies and with local politicians, village assemblies, and other stakeholders in Mirpur near Kushtia, Bangladesh about women's rights and the urgent need to address gender-based violence
